ORDINANCE NO. 1206

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, NEBRASKA RELATING TO APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES TO SELL CIGARETTES AND TOBACCO-RELATED PRODUCTS; TO AMEND SPRINGFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE 9, SECTION 10-904; TO HARMONIZE WITH STATE LAW; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS; AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Chapter 10, Article 9, Section 10-904 of the Springfield Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

§10-904 TOBACCO; LICENSE APPLICATION.

- (A) Every person, partnership, limited liability company, or corporation desiring a license under Neb. RS 28-1420 through 28-1429 shall file with the City Clerk a written application stating:
- (1) The name of the person, partnership, limited liability company, or corporation for whom the license is desired;
- (2) An email address for contacting such person, partnership, limited liability company, or corporation; and
 - (3) The exact location of the place of business.
- (B) Each applicant shall also deposit with the application the amount of the license fee provided in Neb. RS 28-1423.
- (C) If the applicant is an individual, the application shall include the applicant's Social Security number.
- (D) Any Clerk or Finance Department that grants such a license shall notify the Tax Commissioner of such granting and transmit all applicable application materials received to the Tax Commissioner. (Neb. RS 28-1422)
- Section 2. Any other ordinance or code section passed and approved prior to passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions is repealed.
- Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.
