Regular Agenda

Agenda Item 1. Lt. Matt Howey reviewed the Sarpy County Sherriff’s report. Lt. Howey noted that 23 parking tickets were issued in March, further noting the department would like us to send our parking permit log to the Sherriff’s office to assist them in monitoring issued parking passes. Lt. Howey reported that the department has received a Highway Safety Grant to help crack down on distracted drivers.

Agenda Item 2. Kellie Banks, Springfield Memorial Library Director, presented the annual library report, noting they had a good year. Physical material checkouts and digital materials went up this year in both with adults and youth. Puzzles and Library Passes for local area attractions are a big hit. New library cards issued went up by two percent inside city limits and by nine percent outside city limits. They are currently working on getting their historical data into a digital asset management platform and make it searchable. Banks further noted they received a grant to install a storybook walk along the trail that will include 20 book panels. Banks stated they are planning a great event for the library’s 100th year celebration on June 27, 2026. Kathleen Gottsch, City Administrator, noted that with Jean Latham’s, Library Assistant, retirement on April 1, 2026, and future scheduled time off for various library staff members that the library would like to hire an additional part-time employee.

Agenda Item 3. Gottsch reviewed the list of outstanding minor items that need to be addressed for the Springview development. Joe Flaxbeard, Lamp Rynearson, representative for McCune Development, Subdivider, thanked Gottsch for the list, noting that they are currently working on the items. Council Member Murtha introduced Resolution 2026-14 and moved its adoption. Council Member Craney seconded the forgoing motion and on roll call on the passage and adoption of said resolution, contingent on the completion of the list of items is completed, the following voted AYE: Neitzel, Herzog, Murtha, Craney. Springview Final Plat

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, NEBRASKA APPROVING THE FINAL PLAT (LOTS 1-94 AND OUTLOTS A-G, SPRINGVIEW) OF A SUBDIVISION LOCATED ON TAX LOT 37A1A1A IN THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 13 NORTH, RANGE 11 EAST OF THE 6TH P.M., IN SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

WHEREAS, MDC PMG LLC, subdivider, of the above-described property has made application for approval of a final plat for proposed Springview; and

WHEREAS, the city planner, city engineer, city attorney, city administrator and other agencies have reviewed such application; and

WHEREAS, the Springfield Planning Commission held a public hearing on January 13, 2026, regarding the application and has made a recommendation of approval to the City Council of the final plat for Springview, subject to the resolution of items specified in the City Planner's staff report as it meets the general requirements of the zoning ordinance and subdivision regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Springfield held a public hearing regarding such application on March 17, 2026, and is agreeable to the approval of the final plat for Springview, contingent upon (1) final approval of the change of zoning classification from Agriculture Residential to R50 Two-Family Residential, (2) final approval of a Subdivision Agreement for said development, and (3) completion of the conditions identified in Section XXXIV of the Subdivision Agreement.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, NEBRASKA APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A SUBDIVISION AGREEMENT WITH MDC PMG LLC, A NEBRASKA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY (SUBDIVIDER), SANITARY AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO 387 OF SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AND SPRINGVIEW HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION INC. FOR LOTS 1-94 AND OUTLOTS A-G, SPRINGVIEW.

WHEREAS, MDC PMG LLC has requested approval of a Subdivision Agreement for the development known as Springview; and

WHEREAS, the Subdivision Agreement has been reviewed by the city planner, city engineer, city attorney, and city administrator; and

The software will tell what the issues were to better determine which meters need replacing and what the other issues are.

Gottsch reported that, per the Council's direction after discussion at the March 3, 2026, Council meeting, that she approached Horizon Bank regarding the interest rate on the sales tax savings account and they adjusted it. She noted that Pinnacle Bank still wants to do business with the city. The savings account we currently have them has been used to pay ASIP fees. Gottsch asked the Council to look at the treasurer's report to consider a transfer.
