# RESOLUTION 2025-13

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF PROPERTY TO THE SARPY COUNTY AND CITIES WASTEWATER AGENCY (SCCWWA), AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF PROPERTY FROM SCCWWA, GRANTING A PERMANENT SEWER EASEMENT TO SCCWWA, TERMINATING THE GROUND LEASE WITH SCCWWA, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ALL ASSOCIATED CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, SCCWWA and the City of Springfield, Nebraska, signed an Interlocal Agreement for land rights (etc.) about September 7, 2021, that included agreement about the wastewater system, decommissioning, and connection; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions in the agreement have been met; and

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield, Nebraska, a Municipal Corporation, desires to transfer the real property legally described as Tax Lot 3B and Part of Tax Lot 3A1 in the West ½ of the Southwest Quarter of Section 25, Township 13 North, Range 11 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Sarpy County, Nebraska to the Sarpy County and Cities Wastewater Agency; and

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield, Nebraska, desires to acquire the real property legally described as Parcel 1: Lot 154B, Highview Addition, an Addition to the City of Springfield, Sarpy County, Nebraska; Parcel 2: Tax Lot R7 in the Northwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 13 North, Range 11 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Sarpy County, Nebraska; and Parcel 3: Abandoned Railroad Right-of-Way in Section 24, Township 13 North, Range 11 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Sarpy County, Nebraska, from the Sarpy County and Cities Wastewater Agency; and

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield, Nebraska, desires to terminate the Ground Lease Agreement with the Sarpy County and Cities Wastewater Agency on the property legally described as Tax Lot 3B and Part of Tax Lot 3A1, Section 25, Township 13 North, Range 11 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Sarpy County, Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield, Nebraska, desires to convey a permanent sewer easement to the Sarpy County and Cities Wastewater Agency for the right to construct, maintain, and operate a sewer (for sanitary purposes), drainage structure, and/or drainage way, and appurtenances thereto, in, through, and under the parcel of land the City of Springfield, Nebraska desires to acquire.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Governing Body of the City of Springfield, Nebraska, that the Mayor of the City of Springfield is hereby authorized to execute all contract and closing documents pertaining to the land transactions described in this resolution and attached hereto as Exhibit "A."
